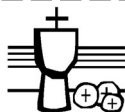

My Dear Parishioners,

The results of the Spring Blood Drive are in! Ben Brescia sent out the call for donors for the April 23rd Drive and our parish family responded. His closing report is inspiring and I want to share it with you . . .

"66 volunteers donated 64 units of life saving blood. As an added blessing 6 donors were able to donate a double red cell unit via a special process using an ALYX machine.

"Many of our zealous supporters encouraged others to donate and some brought along friends and neighbors. It was inspiring to see whole families come out to the drive. I am so grateful that our donors made the effort to get here and donate blood at the end of a very busy and tiring weekday. Because of the caring generous blood donors of St. Sylvester's parish family there are very sick people who will now have a better chance for quicker recovery; perhaps such a gift may even mean survival from a life-threatening situation. This may sound overly dramatic but believe me it is not. After hearing the stories of many blood recipients, I can see that it is true. Without the care and concern of our donors we would not have succeeded as we did. In fact, with God's grace and your generous support, we exceeded by 11 units the New York Blood Center's goal of 53 units of blood for this Drive. Ms. Jennifer McCorry, the NYBC coordinator for Staten Island exclaimed, *'Wow! You did it again, You exceeded the goal!'*

"Although no single person can take credit for this success since it was truly a team effort it is important to particularly recognize the efforts of the NYBC staff whose expert procedures collected the donations, our grand friends at Lifestyles who provided nutritious sandwiches for the donors, and Janet and Jacob Samuels who brought enough cakes and cookies to fill a bakery. As in past drives there was a dedicated core of volunteers which included Pat Bertolini, Barbara D'Aquila, Rose Dellucio, Pat De Respino, Adele Fernandes, Elisa Lopez, Judy O'Donnell, Anne Orton, Frank Quinn, Therese Strianese, and Peter Tesoriero,
